Authentic keyboard action

The KDP70's *Responsive Hammer Compact* (RHC) keyboard action has been developed to reproduce the distinctive touch of an acoustic grand piano. Its springless key mechanism, sturdy construction, and accurate hammer sensing system delivers a smooth, natural, and highly authentic piano playing experience.



Moreover, just as acoustic pianos utilise heavier bass hammers and lighter treble hammers, the RHC keyboard action also employs different hammer weights, appropriately graded for each playing range. Such realistic details provide greater stability during powerful fortissimo passages, while also assisting with pianissimo control.
